

Terms of cooperation protocols

Within the framework of joint cooperation between all parties and based on their desire to establish the foundations of cooperation with the aim of maximizing the exploitation of the scientific and material capabilities available to all parties, including qualified cadres, research centers, laboratories, workshops, production units, consulting and training centers, and other capabilities in order to serve the Egyptian society. The Ministry of Military Production and its organization own a number of factories, industrial companies, human cadres, distinguished research and training centers, and educational institutions in the technical and engineering fields capable of converting the outputs of applied scientific research into industrial products to serve the Egyptian community, in addition to raising the skills of individuals of both parties and graduates so that they qualify them to compete in the labor market. The education system at the Ministry of Military Production includes: technological education at the Applied Technological School in Salam and technical education at the diploma level at Helwan Secondary School for Applied Technology. As well as technical education for the diploma stage above average at the Technical Institute for Advanced Industries in Salam, and the Egyptian Academy for Engineering and Advanced Technology also owns it. Thus, the education system by military production becomes an integrated system

It meets the needs of the Egyptian industry in engineering and technical cadres trained at the highest level in factories, laboratories and production workshops equipped with the latest technological capabilities. In addition to providing training opportunities in the training sector of the Ministry of Military Production, as well as providing opportunities for training, scientific research, transfer and marketing of technology and support for innovation at the Center of Scientific and Technological Excellence in Peace of the National Authority for Military Production. The Ministry is also implementing a number of major national projects through its various institutions and in partnership with the ministries and the sector. Specializing in achieving the comprehensive development plans 2030 and the work of all Egyptian institutions and cooperation as partners in development and integration between productive institutions and the education and scientific research sectors, and seeking to develop higher education institutions and programs in a manner commensurate with the skills and jobs of the future.

Therefore, the will of all parties converged on signing a cooperation protocol between them, which includes the following items:

Fields of Education

•All parties to this protocol agree on the following:

- 1- Cooperation in the field of transferring and marketing technology, supporting ideas, conducting graduation projects for students, and adopting innovative ideas through centers of excellence and the Office of Technology Transfer and Marketing at the Institute, which have applicable outputs that aim to link the outputs of research institutes and the outputs of education with industry and civil society, and the joint supervision of both parties on each What is presented.
- 2- Cooperation in postgraduate studies.
- 3- Cooperation in the use of technical expertise in the completion of engineering consultancy and national projects.
- 4- Cooperate in setting up an employment forum and a joint day for all parties.
- 5- Exchange of experiences in the field of quality.
- 6- Exchanging research, scientific and manufacturing experiences, as well as working to activate research that contributes to solving the problems of the environment and Egyptian society.
- 7- Cooperation in the field of laboratory services.
- 8- Cooperate in supplying and equipping the required laboratories in case there is a need for that.

Fields of Scientific Research And Postgraduate Studies

•All parties agreed to cooperate in the following:

- 1- Research and applied projects of common interest, provided that the objectives of the project and the obligations of the parties are determined through an independent contract for each separate project attached to this Protocol and in accordance with the legal procedures and considered an integral part thereof.
- 2- Holding joint technical seminars and workshops.
- 3 - Joint supervision of master's and doctoral dissertations on research topics of common interest to all parties and civil society, whether they are related to services or products that can be marketed.

Training

All parties agreed to cooperate in the field of scientific visits and student training for the factories and companies of the National Authority for Military Production in return for a financial fee for the factory or company, or to be agreed upon in accordance with the topics of training and the requirements for its implementation, under an independent contract attached to this protocol in this regard, and it was agreed to prepare training content for training technicians According to the training plan for the sector and in accordance with the applicable laws, regulations and systems.

Community Service and Environmental Development

All parties agree to the following:

- 1- Joint cooperation between them in the areas of community service and environmental development in the following areas: Cooperation in preparing and conducting joint training programs for the various human resources of all parties as well as graduates through the use of the capabilities available to them in a way that contributes to raising the skills of trainees in areas of common interest.
- 2- Cooperate in preparing studies, providing consultations, and implementing some tenders to serve the community and develop the environment in matters of common interest.
- 3- Cooperation in the use of technical expertise in the completion of engineering consultancy and national projects.
- 4-Cooperate in developing the capabilities of students and graduates through special training courses.
